Meeting with Teachers

- It is important that, wherever possible, you make an appointment to meet with teachers.
- Teachers have commitments ie Staff Meetings which mean there are nights that they are unable to meet with parents.
- The start of each learning day involves a whole school commitment to our Reading Program so if for any reason your child is late, this is a very difficult time for teachers to talk with you.
- It would be much better to put a note in the communication book or diary explaining why they are late or were absent. Of course, if there is an urgent matter that needs to be conveyed, please do so, but be concise so the teacher is able to get back to working with the class.

Communication Books and Diaries

Communication Books / diaries and all correspondence between families and teachers including emails, is required to be kept for 10 years.

Therefore, at the end of the year teachers will ask for communications books and diaries to be returned, so please be sure they are kept in good order.

Go to the skoolbag console on the homepage of the school website www.epps.sa.edu.au and you are able to **subscribe to email.** You can tick android users and/or newsletters. Ticking 'Android users' will send all school content updates to your email and ticking 'Newsletter' will only send newsletters.

You do not have to be an android user to have newsletters emailed to you if you wish. Follow instructions above.
