The school is offering an Instrumental Music Program during school time, using Private Providers.

The program runs 8 - 10 lessons a term. Instruments offered are

* Saxophone, Trumpet, Clarinet, Flute, Violin and Cello are more costly due to the expense of hiring an instrument therefore numbers often preclude lessons being held at school. If enough students are interested, we will be able to organise a teacher for in school lessons, however, at present for single enquiries, we are able to arrange contact with a music teacher.

If you would like your child to learn a musical instrument during school time, please fill out the form attached and return it to the school via the front office.

If places are available students will begin the term following receipt of their application. The enrolment form will be passed on to the individual teacher concerned who will contact you to confirm a day and time for the student's lesson and to arrange for payment of fees.

Fees are specific to each instrumental teacher, however, below is a general guideline
\$14.00 for a shared lesson of 30 minutes per week consisting of two students or
\$22.00 for individual lesson of 30 minutes per week

Fees can be paid each term or before each lesson either to the instrumental music teacher or may be dropped into the school office. Fees are due and payable on receipt of the student's first lesson. If payment is not received within a two week time frame, parents will be contacted and lessons may be stopped.

If you are in need of a rental instrument, please contact Sue in the school for information or tick the box on the application form attached for a brochure to be sent to you.

Parents will be able to look forward to students performing at our music evenings and the school concert as skill levels grow. .

Joel Cooke, one of our guitar teachers is the coordinator of the school rock band. East Para students are invited to audition for this band. Practice sessions for band are once a week. School band sessions will require some lunch time and out of school hours commitment

JAY TOBIN - Keyboard

Jay is a music specialist with over 40 years of experience performing and teaching piano and vocals, composing, arranging, studio performance and studio production. His lessons are in the Music Room on Fridays and Mondays.

SAM KREIG - Drums and Percussion

Sam takes students for lessons on Tuesday afternoons in the Music Room.

Sam holds a degree from the Adelaide University Conservatorium, now known as the Elder School of Music. He has been playing the drums since he was 7 years old and has been teaching for 5 years at a number of Primary and Secondary schools in Adelaide. His lessons focus on correct technique, without taking away from the fun of music. Sam is excited about the opportunity to teach at East Para and is keen to help build our instrumental music program. Percussion students will need to purchase a book, a practice pad and sticks at an approximate cost of \$75-00.

SAM LIGUORO - Keyboard and Vocals

Sam's lessons are in the Music Room on Wednesdays.

Sam studied Jazz at Adelaide University for 4 years. He has been in bands since he was 11 years old and is a session musician playing with people such as Glen Shorrick and Brian Cadd. Sam is a singer / songwriter and has done commercials for TV. Purchase and hire of keyboards can be arranged through Sam as an alternative to the Musiccorp rates attached. Keyboard students will need to purchase a theory book at a cost of approx \$16-00.

JOEL COOKE – Acoustic, Electric & Bass Guitar

Joel takes students for lessons at East Para in the afternoons.

Joel has a passion for music and performs solo and in bands. He has been teaching guitar for a number of years and is the East Para Out of School Hours Care Director and a swimming instructor.

Joel leads the East Para Primary School Rock Band. Auditions held for membership.

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC TUITION AGREEMENT



This agreement shall continue from term to term.

If you wish to end your music lessons please contact Sue Legierski at the school office on 8264 3944 before commencement of the next term's lessons.

East Para PS students will receive one lesson per week on their chosen instrument; maximum of 2 instruments per student.

Lesson fees are charged per term and are based on either an 8, 9 or 10 week period depending on school activities scheduled.

ACCOUNTS are issued the first week of each term and are payable within 14 days to the music teacher or dropped into the school to be passed onto the teacher. Payments not received by the due date will result in lessons being discontinued.

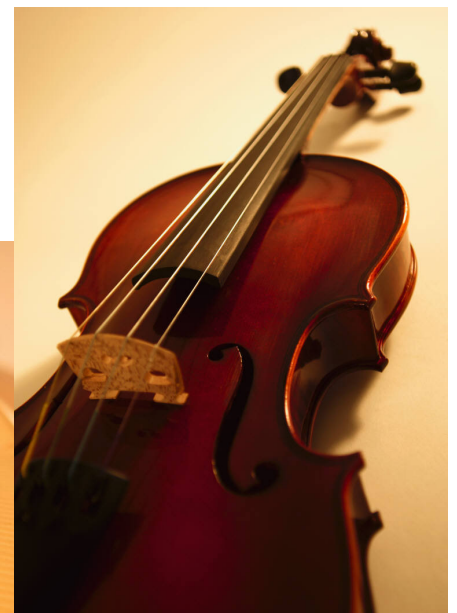
- Lessons may be paid on a weekly basis **before each lesson.**

MOST IMPORTANTLY – MISSED LESSONS

If a student is unable to attend their music lesson for any reason (including school excursion) it is the responsibility of the Parent / Caregiver to contact the Instrumental Teacher on their mobile by 8.00am on that lesson day. In this case, every endeavour will be made to make up the missed lesson depending on school activities scheduled. The Instrumental Teacher is under no obligation to make up or refund lesson fees if notification has not been given before 8.00am on the lesson day.

If the student forgets their instrument or lesson, the lesson may be made up at the discretion of the Instrumental Teacher but without any obligation to do so or to refund any lesson fees.

When the Instrumental Teacher is ill, the school will be informed by 8.00am that morning and students will be notified. It is the responsibility of the Instrumental Teacher to either make up those lessons or credit these onto next term's account.



INSTRUMENT HIRE

Each child is expected to have their own instrument. Guitars, violins and flutes, clarinets, saxophones, trumpets, trombones **will need to be brought to lessons.** Keyboard, drum sticks and drum practice pads **will be needed to practise at home.**

You may:

- Purchase one or use one you already have.
Acoustic guitars can be purchased cheaply at your local music store at around \$75 - \$155 and are not available through Musiccorp to hire. See Michael McConnochie or your teacher if you are having difficulty.
- Hire an instrument **direct from Musiccorp** on the Rent to Buy Scheme, (columns 1 and 2 below). When you rent direct from Musiccorp your rent is deducted from your credit card on a monthly basis and a portion of the rent is deducted from the lease price. You can pay off the lease price at any time, thus purchasing the instrument. Please contact Musiccorp direct on 83018777 for more information.
- **The school does not recommend a specific company, prices below are for you to use as a guide. Hire an instrument from any other musical hire firm that you wish. The school has some contacts they can pass on to you. Please ask Sue.**

To learn drums you do not need to have a drum kit at home. However, Practice pad and sticks are required.

Alto saxophones are only available to students in Year 4 and above. (Size restrictions)
Violin and Cello are offered on a rental only basis.
